

# Carolina Spirit Quest Pagan College Scholarship



Carolina Spirit Quest is a nonprofit, religious organization which was formed in 1995 to encourage networking and the building of community spirit among people who practice Pagan and/or Earth Centered religions in the Carolinas and the surrounding area. The purpose of CSQ is to devote its resources to religious and educational activities.

In accordance with this, CSQ is offering a \$500.00 College Scholarship for a student meeting the attached criteria. Applicants must be enrolled or planning to enroll in a full-time course of study at any accredited two- or four-year college, university or vocational-technical school.

Since CSQ's mission is to promote a Pagan friendly world, this application has been divided into five sections, following the Directions and Elements which many Pagans are familiar with.

I. **East and Air**. *This Direction and Element concern the mind and imagination.* 

This section contains information on the applicant's academic scholarship as well as basic information. This includes the current Grade Point Average, rank in class, and SAT or ACT Scores. It must be signed by your principal or guidance counselor.

II. **South and Fire**. This Direction and Element is often associated with will and energy.

This is the place to list your involvement in community activities and/or accomplishments that were helpful in making you a more involved and contributing individual to your Pagan community. List Rituals, Workshops, seminars and gatherings you have been involved with. What leadership roles did you have in these events? Be sure to include contact information. If you are a solitary, give a brief description of Pagan activities you have developed.

III. West and Water. This Direction and Element involves the power to dare and love.

Include three letters of recommendation for this section. Let others who know you well speak for you. At least one should be from a Pagan leader, and all should contain contact information (phone number and address). Use the suggested Recommendation Letter Form. Feel free to make as many copies as you need.

IV. North and Earth. This Direction and Element represents purpose in life.

List major activities and the level of participation for each (office held, committee assignments, awards, contests, etc.). This may include class offices, club activities, extracurricular student activities, awards, contests, etc. Do not duplicate items listed in Section II above. Include contact information.

V. Center and Spirit. This area symbolizes unity and balance.

This section consists of two short essays. First, explain why the scholarship committee should select you for the CSQ Scholarship. Second, answer the following question: What will I do to help promote a more Pagan friendly world? Each of these should be typed on your own paper, double spaced, using a 12 point font, leaving a one inch margin on each side of the paper and sent in with the application.
